

Sermon Discussion Questions

Ephesians 1:19-23 10/11

- When you are in a tough situation, a situation that seems unsolvable, what do you typically do to deal with it:
 - Try harder to solve it yourself
 - Try to ignore it----watch TV, eat your favorite comfort food, etc.
 - Anger
 - Depression
 - Complain
 - Pray
- Is it hard to believe that the same resurrection power that allowed Jesus to rise from the dead, is actually inside of you as well? Why?
- When you face huge challenges is it hard to keep your gaze on Jesus, who is more powerful than anything you will ever face?
- Do you struggle to see that as a believer, you are vitally connected to Jesus, who is the head of the church?
- How can you keep your gaze on the all-powerful Jesus when you are in the midst of massive challenges and trials?
