

Sermon Discussion Questions

Ephesians 1:13-14 9/27

The text says that believers in Jesus Christ were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit. This means that the Spirit of God authenticates that we are children of God. This is what the Spirit does in our lives. Romans 8:16 tells us-“The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.”

- Do you have the assurance that you are a child of God?
- Do you believe that you are a child of God by God’s grace because you heard the word of truth and believed in Christ alone? (1:13)
- If you are having trouble believing in real time that you are a child of God, what might you need to do in order to recapture that intimate understanding of who you are by the Holy Spirit?
- You have been given an inheritance. What is that inheritance?
- Do you live as if you are sure of your inheritance?
- Are you satisfied by that inheritance?
 - Are you attempting to build a different inheritance for yourself?
 - Are you hoping for a different future than the future that you have been given by the Spirit of God?
