Jesus & the Law: Perfect Together (Matthew 5:17-20)

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions concerning the sermon text:

- What is your gut reaction to God's Law? Be honest.
- Why is linking the law with Jesus so important?
- Do you have trouble reading the Old Testament and seeing how it points to Jesus?
- When we fail to connect the law to Jesus or the OT to Jesus what happens to our reading of the law and the OT?
- When Jesus says that our righteousness must exceed the scribes and Pharisees what should that drive us to?
- Since Christ is the king and He is in the process of establishing His kingdom, what does it mean that the law will not pass away until all is accomplished?
- Read Romans 8:4.
 - Who alone can enable us to live out the law of God?
