Take Your Sin, God's Justice, and God's Mercy More Seriously (Lamentations 3:43-66)

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- How do you typically deal with your sin? Avoid, escape, lament, become paralyzed?
- Why is it important to lament your sin seriously and fully?
- Is it hard to trust God to deal with the injustices that you are experiencing or have experienced?
- Why is trusting God to deal with injustice so important to your spiritual life?
- What would it look like to take God's mercy more seriously? How would it change your personal life? The life of the church?
