Kingdom vs. Kingdom: When the World Opposes the Word (Acts 12)

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- What examples can you think of, where the World may be opposing God and his Word?
- In what areas of your own life, might you be defying God's authority and asserting your own authority?
- Can you think of a time a prayer was answered but you didn't quite believe it? Share it with your group.
- Can you think of a time when you struggled to understand why some prayers were answered and others weren't? What conclusion, if any, did you reach?
- What national or global situations are causing you to need to remind yourself that Jesus is still king?
- What situations in your own life are causing you to need to remind yourself that Jesus is still king?
