

**Discussion Questions - 6/5/22**  
Patterns of Effective Evangelism (Acts 14)

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- What do you think of when you hear the term evangelism or evangelist?
  - What do you think our society thinks when they hear these terms and why?
- In the sermon some of the patterns of “effective evangelism” we saw from Acts 14 were being submersed in the Word, using your natural opportunities, understanding there will be opposition, and having Christian courage in the Holy Spirit. What are some other patterns of “effective evangelism”?
- What does your study of God’s Word look like?
  - Do you find it transforming? If so, share with the group the methods that help make it so.
- Where are your natural opportunities to evangelize?
  - What are some concerns doing this?
- Share a story where you were able to witness or evangelize.
  - How was this received?
- How is Stone Hill Church strengthening and encouraging you?
  - How could it be better? How are you strengthening and encouraging others at Stone Hill Church? How could you do this better?
