The Priorities of Jesus - John 17:1-5

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- When Jesus says, 'My time has come', He is speaking of His death, burial, resurrection, and ascension. All of these events are crucial to God's plan for the redemption of sinful people.
 - How does the death, burial, resurrection, and ascension bring glory to Jesus and to the Father?
- Does the death, burial, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus form a vital part of how you view your life, circumstances and the world? Why or why not?
- Eternal life is described as knowing God.
 - How would you describe your functional understanding of eternal life?
 - Do you see that eternal life is not simply living forever but an entirely new way of seeing the entire world? Why or why not?
- How much of your life, time, and resources are focused on living out this eternal life? Sharing this eternal life with others?
